It is in this background that this unique and holistic approach to the practice of Neurology, Psychiatry and General Medicine has been initiated.

Working under the same roof, various Specialists can interact with each other instantly and thus ensure speedy and accurate identification and management of neurological and psychiatric disorders. This also brings down the cost of diagnosis and treatment.

For the first time in the state, a private Outpatient Clinic – The Neurocenter Cochin – brings together a Team of Senior Neurologists, Senior Psychiatrists, and a General Physician, along with the umbrella services of a Multi-disciplinary team of Psychologists, Special Educators, Speech and Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists and other Rehabilitation Professionals.

Other Senior Consultants in Psychiatry and Clinical Psychology are in the Team.

**Brainwaves** is the Neurology wing of the Neurocenter, manned by a team of Senior Neurologists and a Senior General Physician. This ensures a holistic approach to all neuromedical problems, with a chance for real time cross consultation among them as well as the neuropsychiatric team, when required.

# Outstanding Contributions to the Community through the Profession:

# Pioneering Paradigm Shifts

Pioneered and established General Hospital Psychiatry Unit in a 450- bedded (then) largest Tertiary Referral Hospital in the State of Kerala. Shuttered wards for Psychiatry patients were closed down and the psychiatry inpatient services integrated with General Wards in Neurosciences Division. Revolutionary step in 1980, helping to dispel traditional Stigma and raise awareness and advocacy among general public about Psychiatric disorders.

Mental asylum concept for inpatient treatment in Psychiatry rapidly gave way to this successful initiative of General Hospital and Consultation Liaison Psychiatry. The Secretary of the Indian Psychiatric Society then said that this pioneering concept enabled to 'de-stigmatise Psychiatry in this part of the world', and made these services "available and accessible to the needy people in the community".

# Open - Office Polyclinic: Heralding another Paradigm Shift

The ease with which Psychiatry patients can take a consultation without stigma or loss of dignity was made possible in 1991 when Dr Philip John pioneered in Kerala for the first time Peejays Polyclinic which turned out to be the meeting place in Cochin for Psychiatry and related medical disciplines in Neurosciences; and for umbrella-services like Clinical Psychology and several Community based Services under one roof.

This model has now become popular in town after town in Kerala and has made it possible for the needy in the community to avail and access psychiatric help in the comfort of a dignified outpatient setting. Leaders in the medical profession in Kerala vouch for this contribution.

# Pioneering Services Nationally for Children with

# Learning Disorders ('dyslexia') in India:

# the Most Outstanding Contribution

Dr Philip John's research and studies in Child Psychiatric Disorders including Learning Disorders continued during these years. His most outstanding contribution to the Community in India has been identifying and working on this niche area from a neurological perspective.

For the first time in India in 2005, Dr Philip John designed a Community-based Project called Child Care Centre in Cochin, in association with the Ernakulam District Council for Child Welfare under the Chairmanship of the District Collector, and the Indian Academy of Pediatrics Charitable Society. The elected Medical Director testifies how Dr Philip John pioneered the concept and built the services of the Centre on a regular daily basis brick by brick to serve thousands of children with this Neurological Disability - who make 10% of our children's population.

The Union of India Ministry of Social Justice & Welfare invited Dr Philip John to Delhi as Expert on Learning Disorders and Autism Disorders for the final deliberations on the Persons with Disabilities Act (amendments), 1995. The then Secretary of the Ministry wrote that "the final discussions was held with the most eminent experts in the country in various areas of Disorders..."

# Turning Point in Learning Disorders in India

The real breakthrough to take this mammoth problem in children to the Community came when Dr Philip John was invited by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) to be the Keynote Speaker at the National Conference of Principals of CBSE Schools at Nagpur on October 19-21, 2000. Training Programmes for Principals, School Counselors and Teachers of CBSE Schools ensued.

The CBSE then invited Dr Philip John and his Team in 2001 to Delhi for a major Community effort of Training Master Trainers focusing on Learning Disorders in school children.

The sheer force of numbers of school children (over 10% of them) afflicted by this disorders in our country made it vital to train teachers of all schools - for Classrooms and Resource Rooms.

For this mammoth community effort, Dr Philip John and his Team drew up a modus operandi of creating "Educational Diagnosticians and Therapists" out of ordinary school teachers. The result was the 'Handbook on Poor School Performance' written by Dr Philip John and published and used by the CBSE in all its Affiliated Schools (2002). All these activities were undertaken without remuneration.

Under the aegis of the CBSE, and the Sahodaya Complexes, Dr Philip John "has been conducting workshops for CBSE schools, teachers, parents and children – across the country" (Director CBSE); again without any remuneration.

During the Platinum Jubilee of the CBSE in 2004, "eminent Educationists who have excelled in their respective fields of work were invited by the CBSE to deliver Lectures". Dr Philip John's Lecture, "Dualism Between Schooling and Education: Bridging the Gap" along with the other Series Booklets (Dr Karan Singh, Dr Anil K Gupta, Dr Pritam Singh, Dr Ashok Ganguly were the other separate authors) were presented for benefit the community at the Platinum Jubilee Valedictory Function on July 28,2004 graced by the Hon'ble President of India, Dr APJ Abdul Kalam and the Union HRD Minister Shri Arjun Singh at Vigyan Bhavan, Delhi.

# Pioneering Effort: Impact Nationally for School children with Learning Disorders

Following all these efforts, Children with Learning Disorders began to be identified clearly by Teachers, especially in the CBSE Schools. Resource Rooms were established based on the framework in the Handbook authored by Dr Philip John and his Team. Ultimately, children with this and other Developmental Disorders were allowed, as their right for equal opportunities, to avail extra time to write, drop or choose study subjects based on their skill deficits, and a host of other reforms in the CBSE for children with Disorders. The then CBSE Chairman, Mr Ashok

Ganguly, Director(Academics) Mr Balasubramonian, Controller of Examinations Mr M C Sharma, Education Officer Dr Sadhana Parashar were all behind these reforms.

As an inevitable follow up, State Educational Boards across the country especially after SSA, have also now moved to give such educational/examination provisions for these (10% of school population) mammoth number of afflicted children.

The Indian media, both print and electronic have now periodic discussions on these 'silent' handicaps including the visual media, 'Taare Zamin Par' for example.

# Research, Writings and Publications on Learning Disorder

Besides multitude of writings and articles in LD in the popular media, both newspapers and TV channels, a 5 Lecture Series by Dr Philip John on these Disorders and Autism Disorders are telecast by the State Institute of Education Training(SIET) on DD Education Channel in Kerala. Several repeat telecasts have been made since the past years in view of the popularity of these lectures and repeat requests to raise awareness and advocate remediation for these Disorders in the community.

The Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) has also aired a series of Lectures by Dr Philip John and team on Doordarsan Educational Channel on the same subject. All these have been done free by the Team. The 'Week' magazine has published two popular 'Booklets' distributed free of cost, authored by the Team.

# International Outreach for LD

A great international recognition for Dr Philip John's work with Dyslexic children came when John Wiley and Sons, UK, the prestigious Medical Publishers in London invited Dr Philip John to contribute the chapter on 'Dyslexia in India' in their 'International Book of Dyslexia'. The royalty was donated to the Marion Welchman Memorial Dyslexia Trust.

Sage Publications Delhi, London published a Book on Learning Disorders where Dr Philip John has presented his thesis on 'psychological disorders co-existing in school children with dyslexia' in an exclusive chapter.

Dr Philip John's work in the Middle East followed one of his international publications, picked up by the UAE print media which published his writings on ADHD and Learning Disorders in children.

## Pioneering Child Guidance Clinic in UAE

90% of the population in UAE are expatriates, and Indians in UAE form one third of this population. Among these Indians, 20% are children below 14 years of age. There used to be no medical or dedicated psychiatric help available for the substantial number of Indian school Children with Learning Disorders in UAE.

Dr Philip John took up this major issue with the then President of the Kerala Medical Graduates Association (AKMGA) in UAE and Chairman of a major Healthcare Group in UAE. This resulted in

the establishment of a pioneering Child Guidance Clinic in UAE with him at the head, and a full fledged Team of umbrella services to care for children with Learning Disorders and Autism. He visits the clinic for a week every month where his services are accessible even "to the distressed low income group of Indians" in UAE – a pioneering effort for the Indian Community in that part of the world.

Across UAE, the team has been conducting school-by-school Workshops for Teachers and Parents. Doctors, especially Paediatricians are trained by the team to identify and redress these childhood disorders, through periodic CME programs for doctors and counselors. Teacher Enrichment Programs are routinely undertaken by the Team from school to school.

The CGC in UAE functions as a unique oasis of help for the afflicted children of Indian Community in the UAE.

# Community Outreach Programmes

Dr Philip John's Child Guidance Clinic (CGC) at Cochin has a dedicated Team which conducts Workshops and Seminars for Teachers, Parents and Students on a regular basis in CBSE and State Board Schools, based on strategies to deal with "Learning and other Developmental Disorders" in school children.

A one year course in LD and its remediation is run at the CGC for Teachers in Kerala. They are capacity-built to start resource rooms for these Special Needs Children in the respective schools.

The WHO India Country office collaborated with Dr Philip John and his Team to address this Disorders as well as disaster-trauma-related issues in 7 random Districts in Kerala. Teacheradministrated strategies were developed by conducting Workshops in these Districts for Teachers from Government schools. The effort is available with the WHO India Country office and in its website in pdf format.

# PEEJAYS FOUNDATION

A non-profit Foundation registered in Cochin as a Trust, registered with both the Registrar of Charitable Societies and with the Income Tax Commissioner has been actively functioning under the leadership of Dr Philip John from 2006 December.

The objects of the Foundation are to execute the projects to give relief for the needy, sick and disabled in the community. Also to enrich clinical excellence among doctors and paramedical professionals so that the quality of delivery of healthcare in the community is enhanced; especially in psychiatry and related neurosciences.

Awareness workshops, Advocacy Programs, free workshops and seminars and free medical camps are regular activities of the Foundation.

Also are the continuing Hands-on Training Programs for young psychiatrists from various parts of the country, free block placement for various field training on-hands for M.Phil students from various institutions/universities across the country and for in service teachers from schools of Kerala.

# New Vistas in Psychiatry

- Novel concepts in Developmental Disorders including Learning Disorders in children have been propounded by Dr Philip John such as the 'Spectrum Construct'. (Indian Journal of Psychiatry, Volume 52 (suppl) January 2012, page S226)
- New clinical concept of Autism Disorders in children, with separation of high functioning Autistic Children, thus clearly delineating a 'Treatable Group' of ASD.
- These new concepts have enabled the pioneering of successful treatment regimens using also medications, in addition to the Multi-disciplinary strategies for these disabled children.

This success at treatment of these children is the Hallmark of the multidisciplinary management in Dr Philip John's Child Guidance Clinic (CGC) at Kochi, Kerala and CGC, Sharjah, UAE.

Psychiatry, which is the youngest branch of Medicine, is perceived and practiced by him as the application of basic neurosciences to human behavior.

And this trajectory continues, with his vision of creating an Institution that will comprehensively serve all these clinical needs in Psychiatry, Behavioral Sciences, and related Neurosciences – all under the same roof...
