Psychiatry

Psychiatry itself is a new branch of Medicine. It is now practised as application of basic Neuro-sciences to every person's day-to-day problems; this has helped to remove the old misconceptions and stigma about psychiatric consultations.

The Mind

Using the latest research techniques, doctors today know that the Mind is generated by the Brain; we 'think' and 'feel' inside the brain. Mind's functions such as Speaking, Thinking, Feeling, Learning, Reading, Writing etc. are carried out by specific biochemicals in designated areas of the Brain.

Child Psychiatry

Any developmental delay or later dysregulation in designated brain areas can cause Learning Disorders, Attention Deficit Disorders (ADHD), Autism, Speech and Language Disorders etc. in children, as well as Behaviour and Emotional Disorders.

With the rapidly-changing family and social structure in these times, Learning and Behaviour Problems in children have compounded.

Hence the emergence of Child Psychiatry as a subspeciality.

Child Guidance Clinic (CGC)

The Team

Unlike in adults, children tend to have an overlap of Developmental, Neurological, Academic and Emotional disorders - at the same time, in the same child. Therefore, a Team of Specialists from all related fields is required to valuate children with difficulties. Such a Multi-disciplinary approach is made possible in the Child Guidance Clinic (CGC) by having Clinical and educational Psychologists, Social Workers, Special Educators, Language Pathologist, Speech Therapist and Psychiatrist in the Team for appropriate guidance or

treatment.

- Professional Co-ordinator, Clinical Psychologists
- Special Educators, Social Workers
- Educational psychologist, Language Pathologists
- Consultant Neuro-physician, Consultant Psychiatrist

The Setting

This team work in the open setting ofthe CGC encourages Children and their Parents to walk in and seek help for Learning Difficulties, Emotional Problems or Poor School Performance without fearor stigma.

Our Schools also must have access to an authentic Resource Centre with various Specialists, where they can confidently seek an expert opinion about the child's performance in order to help him/her.

Children who need the Services

Many difficulties in children may be just variations of the normal; even so, a professional evaluation is called for :

Poor School Performance (PSP) and Learning Disorders (LD) to understand the causes in each child
Various levels of Intelligence (IQ) and types of Intelligence
Academic Skill Deficits in Reading, Writing, Spelling, Maths etc.
Speech and Language Disorders, Stuttering, aphasias
Motor skill deficits - poor handwriting, culmsiness etc.
Attention Deficit Disorder (ADHD); Concentration / Memory problems
Eating and sleep disturbances, bedwetting, nail biting etc.
Overactivity, Aggression, Bullying
Defiant/Oppositional Behaviour. Conduct Disorders
Addiction to TV / Computer; disorganised routines
Tics / Tourette disorder, 'Silent' Epilepsy
Obsessive Behaviour and Disorders; procrastination etc.
Anxiety, School Phobia, Exam phobia and various fears in the child.
Depression, social withdrawal, loss of interest;
Developmental Neurological disorders.
'Functional symptoms like Headache, Breathlessness, Stomachache, frequent sickness, absenteeism from school etc.

These are some of the difficulties that need to be checked out by a Team of Specialists. Such a facility is provided in one single centre as the CGC.

Stages of Evaluation: PROTOCOL

i) Intake Interview:

Major step in diagnosis, with details from parents, child, report from teacher and samples from the child's work etc. To identify the child's problems and to determine which other specialist needs to examine the child, if necessary.

ii) Physical/ Neurological Examination:

Especially to inlude soft neurological signs, hearing, vision etc, may be done by the doctor where necessary.

Tests like EEG or other investigations done if necessary as an affordable package

iii) Assessing Overlapping Disorders:

This forms a significant part of our evaluation unlike other centres which are not multi-disciplinary. Other co-existing Disorders are identified in the child by focussed evaluation and multi-axial diagnosis.



iv) Assessment of Poor School Performance (Learning Disorders):

The basic sets of assessments include:

- Tests of General Intelligence (IQ).
- Grade-based Assessment of Reading Skills, Writing and Spelling Skills, Maths and Language Skills,
 Concentration, Comprehension, Handwriting, Learning Skills / strategies. Pre-academic skills.
- Tests of Speech and Language development.
- ☐ Neurological assessment / EEG etc.
- Identification of Special abilities / Skills.
- v) Multidisciplinary Diagnosis and documentation
- vi) Psychoeducation, Guidelines and Counselling


